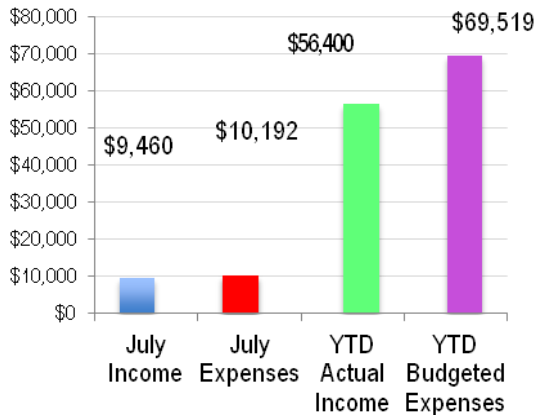


Local Church Finances

Prayer Request Dear Church Family, It has been over a year since we had asked for prayer for our grandson, Nathan, who was soon to be born with some special needs. Once again, we are asking for prayer as a big surgery for him is coming up on August 22nd at MCV in Richmond. As most of you know, he has Apert Syndrome which causes premature closing of sutures in the skull as well as conjoined fingers in both hands and toes. This upcoming surgery is one of several that will release his fingers and release his toes. It is a long surgery and tedious, for there are small nerves and blood vessels to deal with as well as many, many tiny stitches to be made and skin grafts to get the fingers covered. He will have both arms and legs in casts for at least 2 weeks. It will be a trying time!
