If you don't already have the Zoom App, it will prompt you to download it. Once you go through that process, you will be asked to enter the **Meeting ID: 681 961 391**

If you prefer to join only by phone, like joining a phone conference, dial this number **(646-558-8656)** and enter the meeting ID number when prompted.

If this is your first time using Zoom, I'd encourage you to install the Zoom App ahead of time by simply clicking the link above. If you need help, feel free to call Pastor Denny for technical support.

Virtual Worship Considerations We have chosen to use Zoom versus Facebook Live to protect the privacy of children which may become involved. We also have chosen to meet before 11am to allow individuals the option of tuning in to other live presentations offered by HopeTV.


Bob Wine is recovering at home after being hospitalized for an infection in his throat.
